Key Responsibilities:

Build capacity for the Housing Department, working to evaluate and improve the intake and follow-up processes, plan and implement a homebuyer workshop series, and assist in the coordination of the Alton Home Repair program. This is a year-long AmeriCorps VISTA position.

This position is a part of the Housing Action VISTA Network, which is an AmeriCorps VISTA program managed by Housing Action Illinois since 2010. As such, this position will receive customized training, support, guidance, and networking opportunities, in addition to the traditional opportunities for AmeriCorps VISTA positions.

 - Identify education topics, presenters, and partners
 - Create and disseminate marketing materials
 - Conduct outreach
 - Research local products and update homeownership guide
